


Early childhood matters...

- Improved academic success
- Increased career/earning achievement
- Improved health outcomes
- Less likely to have teen pregnancy
- Less likely to be involved in the criminal justice system
- Less likely to abuse drugs

nearly 50% of children are not ready to succeed when they start kindergarten
