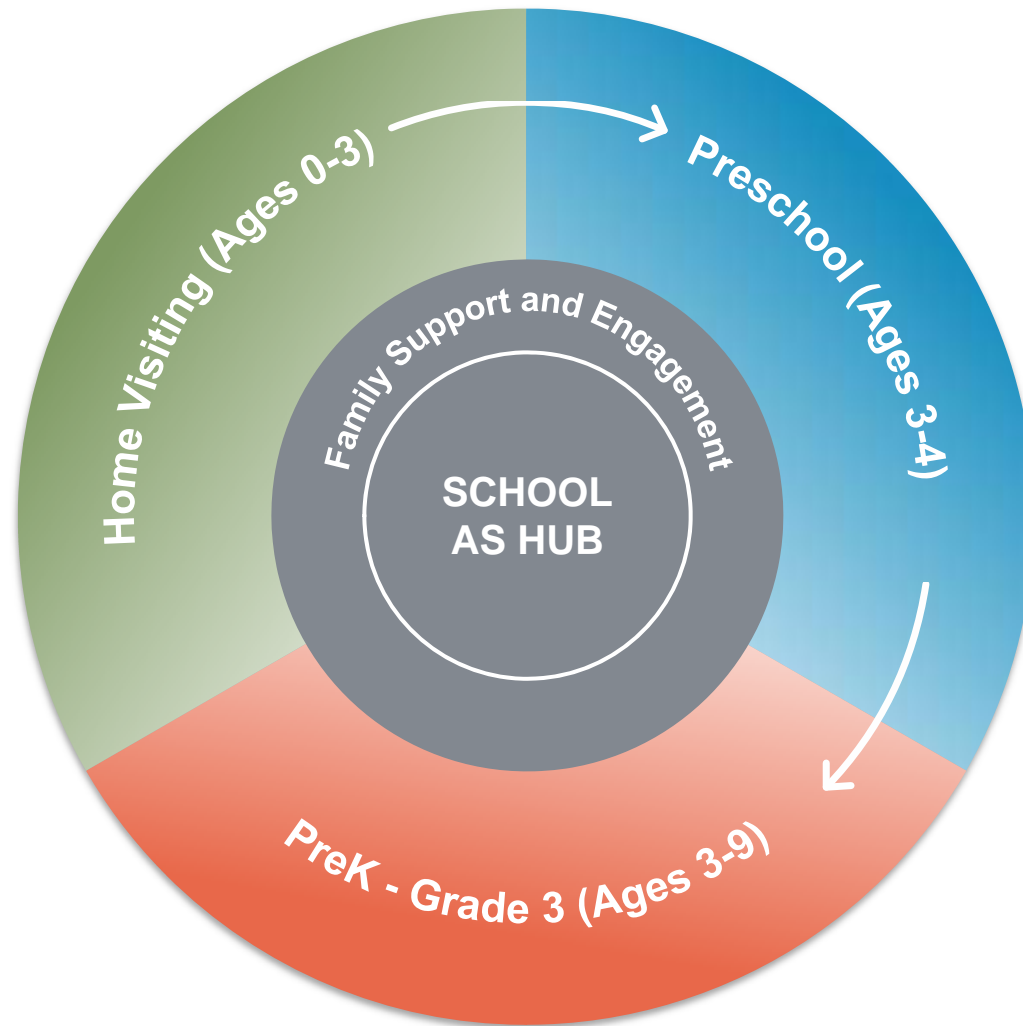

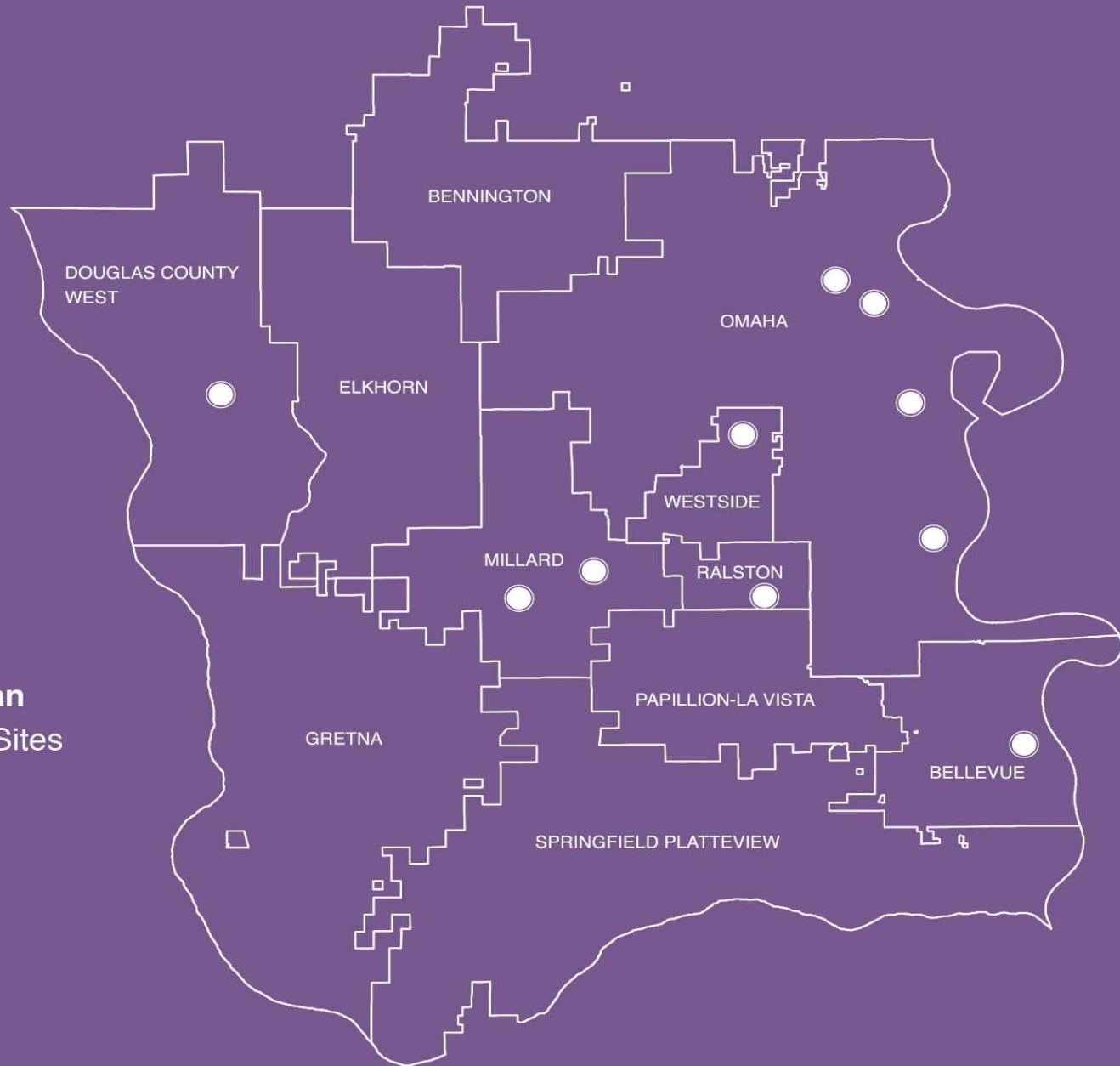

# Themes of the day

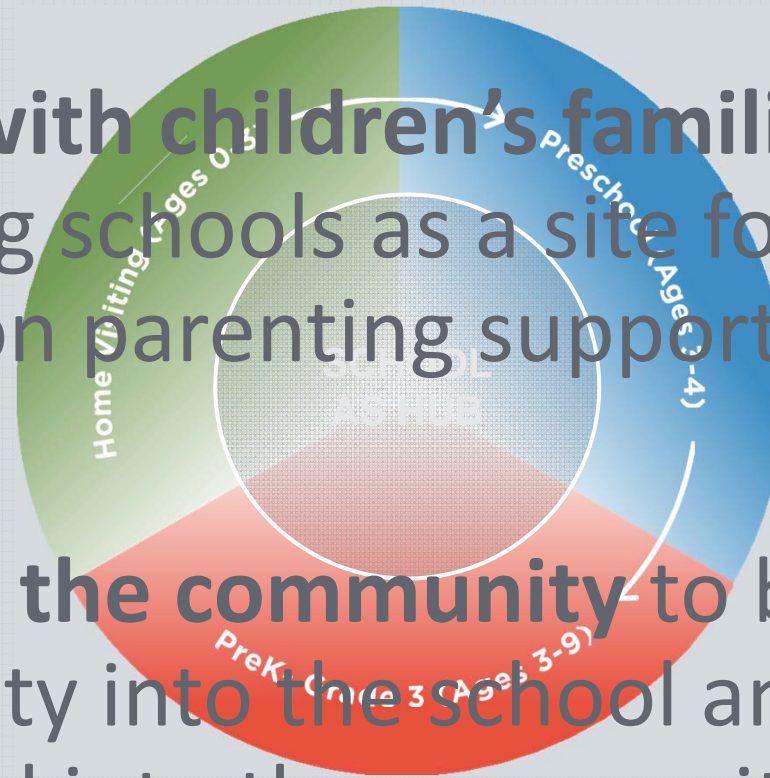
- **Start early** – embrace a collective sense of responsibility for children starting at birth
- **Build predictable pathways and transitions** from birth - 3, into preschool, and through K – 3<sup>rd</sup> and beyond



- **Promote high quality** at each step along the birth – grade 3 pathway

- **Partner with children's families**, leveraging schools as a site for 2-generation parenting supports

- **Join with the community** to bring the community into the school and to take the school into the community
